POWER GRID set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn and was kept to task through the lane while much the best. SARGEANT OF ARMS was in range early, closed the gap on the far turn and was clearly second best. MR. MAYACCO had no speed, had a mild gain on the far turn and was up for show. NAUGHTS NOT KNOTS was well back and roused from the four path on the far turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no impact. INDISUN was away alertly and hustled along on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch leveled off. VIGOR'S APPEAL was off the pace, saved ground on the far turn in a dull effort. BOUNTY REGENT was in mid pack early but pulled up in the stretch.
