BENT ATTORNEY broke smartly then took on outside rival and vied into the turn, tracked that one into the stretch, bid outside and took command in mid stretch to prove best. DANCING ALLSTAR hustled outside and vied briefly, led on the turn then was challenged by outside foe and gave way while a clear second best. KLISSURA came from off the pace to put in a belated off the rail run and was up for the show. BOLD MANEUVER chased the speed and had contact through the turn then evened out in the run to the wire. DASHINGALLTHEWAY raced off the pace and was never a serious factor. HEREISTHERING was no match for the others and never close.
