TEACHER BOYNE stalked the early leader, took the lead into the turn, had a clear lead in the stretch and was all out. SPREAD THE NEWS was in range, gained ground on the turn and was second best. KILMOGANNY was back early, eight path at the top of the stretch and rallied outside. FIJI BOY stumbled and lost irons at the break, moved up on the turn and closed willingly in the lane. ALL ABOUT MAMA set the pace, vied into the turn, three path at the top of the stretch and weakened in the lane. WILD DIAMOND was in touch, had a mild gain on the turn, six path at the top of the stretch and needed more. LAST TO FIRST was off the pace, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late rally. WHISKEYONTHEROCKS was up close, lost ground on the turn and gave way.
