CATHY'S CONDO rated in the early going, angled to the inside to track the leaders, angled out at the quarter pole, bid widest and was full out to prevail. ARMISTICE DAY came from off the pace after saving ground, angled out turning for home, bid from inside of the winner and just missed. BUBBLY BROOKE had speed to show the way, held sway into mid stretch then faltered late. VASKRISSENYA trailed before passing tired ones with a mild gain in the drive. BUCKAROO MISS tracked the speed from off the rail then faded on the far turn. UNREAL DREAM was close up and chasing the speed for six then gave way in the drive. TOUGH RAMBLER stalked the speed for six furlongs then faded.
