Footnotes

DASHING MONTY tracked the leaders then followed the front runner into the stretch while off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter, took charge at the furlong pole and drew off. AMERICAN SIGNATURE had speed, led the way after shaking off early pressure, kept the lead into the stretch then tired inside in the drive. HONEST ACCOUNTANT in mid pack, had a mild gain to be a factor on the far turn then ran evenly off the rail to the wire. CUSACK came from the trailing spot to make up ground and bid in the four path, put in a mild bid through the stretch but came up short. CRY HAVOC lost ground from mid field and was not a stretch factor. TETHRA'S RIPPER was off the pace and had no rally. SERGEI pressed early, backed off and was all done turning for home.
