JUDGE RELIC KELIC came from off the pace to close from the rail, found room and bid inside entering the stretch then outfinished rival to the wire. SINFUL PLEASURES closed ground and bid 4-wide turning for home then was full out but could not reach the winner though finishing with good energy. FRIENDLY PIONEER was well back then closed into the stretch from off the rail and found her best stride late. PERSUE closed ground from the inside but lacked a serious stretch rally. ROYAL GATE in mid field, put in an even effort while finishing wide in the stretch run. LINDSEY'S DOVE had an early bid to challenge for the lead after going a half, dueled through the far turn then tired. QUICK SILVER MISS showed little in an off the pace try. SMART PURSUIT dueled for the early lead, changed challengers, kept on the engine through the far turn then faded. CASE OF PRIDE had a bad stumble at the break then failed to recover. TRUE EXPECTATIONS dueled briefly then faded.
