FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD THAT HAVE STARTED AT FORT ERIE TWO TIMES OR MORE IN 2012. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$250 when making entry with a purse of \$30,000 which includes \$5,000 for eligible Ontario Breds. Horses not originally nominated may supplement at time of final entry for \$600 which includes the entry fee. Weights: Three Year Olds, 116 lbs. Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of three races in 2012 allowed, 2 lbs.; Of two races in 2012, 4 lbs.; Of one race in 2012, 6 lbs. (Races with claiming prices of \$7,500 or less not considered for allowances). The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2011-2012. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. This is a non Black Type race. Closed Thursday, June 28th. with 18 Nominations (1 Supplement).

MOUNTAIN ECHO tracked the early leaders, had a bid from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch proved best. STRIKING MISS was in mid pack, hustled along on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. GRACE BY MOONLIGHT was off the pace, had a mild gain from the three path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch was up for show. TIME SHARING was away alertly, dueled on the turn and chased at the top of the stretch but evened out. HIGHS AND LOWS was in touch and roused from the inside on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch leveled off. CLASSICAL HUMOUR had no speed and was roused on the turn but lacked a late response. APRIL HALO was unhurried early and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path through the stretch lacked a serious bid. MIS BELVEDERE was well back, showed little and had no impact. MY NATALIE showed speed and dueled on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch came up empty. MOLINARO RUSH was in mid field but dropped back on the turn and was not a factor.
