Footnotes

DELAFORCE stalked the early leaders, had a good inside position on the far turn and rallied to get up in time. LONESOME CHEROKEE tracked the early leaders, had a bid from the three path on the far turn and led from the five path at the top of the stretch but was caught late. FLIP FOR THE COIN had no speed, was roused from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch had a good effort. SHANGHAI KNIGHT was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and passed tired foes to get up for a share. CAVALIERDANCER forced the pace and dueled from between foes on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch was empty. MICHAEL'S BAD BOY set a pressured pace and dueled from the inside on the far turn but tired in mid stretch.
