SUPREME PROSPECT stalked the speed battle into the turn in a good trip, bid outside and took command then drew off with authority. PETITE DIVA well back early, closed ground and was full of run in a wide drive to be up for second best. PEYTES DEED TOLIFE had good speed to duel for the lead, shook off rival but was not able to match the winner and tired inside in the drive. BACHELORETTE chased the speed trio and then bid from off the rail in the stretch but it was not enough to crack the top three. NOT TONIGHT HONEY unhurried in the early going, was on the rail into the stretch then lacked the needed kick. SAUCY SALITA was off slow and never in it. ABEGWEIT was off slow, raced well back and was not a factor. MOLINARO KISS dueled inside and battled into the turn but had nothing left for the stretch and tired. HONORS VIXEN faded from mid pack and then trailed the field home.
