WICKEN REDE had sharp speed to vie between foes into the turn, dueled outside of rival on the turn, shook clear then drew away with authority. SEVEN IS THE CHARM had speed to duel for the lead, was in the battle on the turn, could not go with the winner turning for home but ran on from the inside to be clear of the rest. IMAMYTO had five wide speed to press early, tracked on the turn then put in a mild bid to catch the show. LADY ARCHER off the early pace, gained ground, was inside of foes for the stretch run and had a mild try. PRECOSIOUS WILLY raced wide throughout and lacked the needed stretch kick. WAR CREST DANCER off the pace and on heels of foes while steadying briefly on the turn, was wide for the drive but needed more. KIRI JANA failed to threaten and was vanned off. NOT SO WICKED was 4-wide and pressing early, tracked the leaders on the turn then lacked the needed finish. VANESSA DANCER off the pace, lacked a rally while finishing inside. RED PENNY had 6-wide speed to press into the turn then faded. SCARLET LILY trailed then passed a tired one. DARK LOCHNAGAR had brief speed between foes then was done early.
