### Footnotes

CAPUCINE in mid field gained ground, into the far turn, was inside and bidding into the stretch then led and was kept to task in an off the rail drive. SUPERTRAMP tracked the speed and kept the leader in her sights for six, then bid 3-wide into the stretch, loomed a danger but was outgunned to the wire. A TWIST OF SHERREE had speed to open a gap and lead for six under fast fractions, was challenged inside and out into the stretch then gave way but managed to save the show. BACKSTRETCH GOSSIP came from off the pace to put in a late try but could not reach the show spot. TINKER'S HOPE tracked from off the rail and was in the game for six then faded. BIT SHEE BELIEVER well back throughout, had no rally.
