ONE MORE DAY stalked the leaders and kept close, split foes turning into the stretch then took command in mid stretch and was kept to task. JUAN BAY B BULL had a mild steady into the first turn, was off the pace, gained into the far turn, was in the four path for the drive the had his best stride late. LATIN AWAD vied for the lead from outside of foe, put that one away and led into the stretch then gave way to the top two in the final furlong. UNCLE FERDS stalked the leaders in a good trip into the far turn, bid 3-wide, loomed a danger then finished evenly. NO. ONE MOVE was steadied inside on the first turn, saved ground, had a three path run in the drive but lacked a serious kick. CLASSIC RUCKIS dueled for the lead, was still a factor on the far turn while giving way then tired. ALPHA TRICK was off the pace and did not fire. JACK DANCING trailed early and was never close. INVADING THOUGHTS hit the gate on the break then raced erratic early going inside then out, got to mid pack then faded. HARLEY ON BARLEY veered out at the break, was well back and never a factor.
