NICE CASE was away alertly, set the pace, had a clear lead at the top of the stretch and was much the best. SERGEANT MATT stalked the leader, was roused on the turn and from the three path through the stretch was second best. D' ARTAGNAN had no speed, saved ground on the turn and was up for show. INDY JOE was off the pace and moved up on the turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch leveled off. STORMY COMET was in touch and hustled along on the turn but weakened late. CHARMING KISSES was unhurried early, trailed the field on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. PORTO RUSKAS was in range and chased from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no kick. LONE ENDEAVOR was back early, showed little and was never a threat.
