### Footnotes

LET'S GO BEAR was up close, a factor on the turn and from the three path through the stretch proved best. JAZ RYDER was off the pace, roused from the inside on the turn and closed willingly through the stretch. O B THE BEST was in touch and saved ground on the turn and with a bid through the stretch was all out. CALIBRATOR was unhurried early, trailed the field on the turn and had a belated rally through the stretch. LOVE THAT DUDE in range and had a bid from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch evened out late. NEAR EXPECTATIONS was hustled early and had the lead on the turn but tired in mid stretch. ICY HUMOUR showed speed but chased from between foes on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch faded. JENPEG was in mid pack, raced evenly from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch failed to fire. MORECURRYINAHURRY was back early and had a mild gain from the four path on the turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch flattened out.
