KWIK COSTA was in range, moved up on the far turn, had a bid at the top of the stretch and fought gamely for the win. EDGE was unhurried early, closed the gap from the three path on the far turn and with the lead at the top of the stretch was outgunned. TYLER'S JEWEL was off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch closed. WONDEROUS GLORY was up close and had a good inside position on the far turn but evened out. BRIGHT HERO set a pressured pace and had a slim lead on the far turn but gave way through the stretch. CAN'T BE PETE was well back and raced evenly on the far turn but from the five path at the top of the stretch had no impact. SAY CHEESE forced the pace but chased on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was empty. HIGH PLATEAU was in mid pack but lost ground on the far turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was outdistanced.
