ZIPCO stumbled at the start, moved up from the four path on the turn and from the seven path through the stretch proved best. MONO CLIFFS showed speed from the inside, set the pace but was headed at the top of the stretch and fought gamely in defeat. BETTER BELIEVE was up close, forced the pace on the turn and was a factor from the three path through the stretch but was outfinished. FREEDOMBID was unhurried early and was hustled along from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch finished evenly. MAXIOM was off the pace, trailed the field on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. EUCLID AVENUE stalked the early leader and had a good position on the turn but from the four path through the stretch leveled off. GIVEALITTLEMORE had no speed and was roused from the inside on the turn but had no response.
