AND I WILL was in mid pack and had a bid from between foes on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch needed more. CONCRETE KEVIN was off the pace and hustled along from the four path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch had no late kick. TRY RUNNING was back early and clipped heals on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch finished evenly. MOLINARO JEWEL set the pace and had the lead on the far turn but tired at the top of the stretch. INDISUN stalked the leader and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch had no rally.
