Footnotes

DISBELIEF was unhurried early, circled foes on the far turn, took the lead in mid stretch and proved best. PATATI PATATA set the pace, was pressured on the far turn, had the lead at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. DERBY FOX was in touch, had a good position at the top of the stretch but lacked the needed kick. GATO ESPACIAL stalked the leader, vied between foes on the far turn and leveled off in the drive. DASHING MONTY trailed the field, had a mild gain from the three path on the far turn but had no late response. SEVENTEEN RED was in mid pack, saved ground on the far turn and backed away in the stretch. OUTFLANKER'S TOKEN was off the pace, roused from the four path at the top of the stretch and gave way.
