TUFF CHICK settled early, closed ground, split foes on the far turn then bid 4-wide in the drive and rallied willingly. LADY IN TAILS had speed to show the way from off the rail, kept on the engine, was pressed in the drive but held on gamely for the place. CHANCEISALADY pressed the pace from the outside and kept the heat on throughout, bid and completed a good try. NATIVE BRICK stalked the pace then put in an inside rail try. LA PRINCESSE JOLIE trailed and passed a tired one. LADY SHARI was close up and stalking from the outside then faded on the stretch turn.
