Weights: Three Year Olds, 116 lbs. Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of three races in 2009 allowed, 2 lbs; Of two races in 2009, 4 lbs.; Of one race in 2009, 6 lbs. (Races with claiming prices of \$7,500 or less not considered for allowances). The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2008-2009. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. Closed Thursday, July 2nd. with 14 Nominations. This is a non Black Type race.

CHOCOLATEFORLUNCH pressed the pace and vied into the turn, backed off slightly, the pressed again from between foes turning for home, led with a furlong to go and proved best in the drive to the wire. SNOW RITE had inside speed to duel for the lead, held a slim lead on the turn, was challenged again by the winner and gave way to that one while running on to save the place. ROSIE REGENT stalked the leaders and then bid 3-wide turning for home, could not get to the top two in the final furlong while finishing off a good try. AFRICAN RAINBOW trailed the field before making a belated outside run at the three top finishers but arrived too late while going well.. SELECTIVE SHOPPER stalked outside in the early going then lost ground to the leaders and had no stretch rally. WALTZING TIME was off slowly and was never a threat.
