For Fillies and Mares, Three-Year-Olds and Upward, Foaled in Canada. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$600 when making entry. Three-Year-Olds, 116 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of three races at a mile or over in 2003 allowed 2 lbs.; Of two races at a mile or over in 2003 allowed 4 lbs.; Of one race at a mile or over in 2003 allowed 6 lbs. [Races with claiming prices of \$7,500 or less not considered for allowances] The field will be limited to 12 starters. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to the highest earnings in 2002- 2003. Up to \$3,795 Breeder Awards. \$30,000 of this purse has been provided through the Thoroughbred Improvement Program and Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society. Nominations closed Thursday, July 3, 2003.

AGOLO stalked the leaders from the inside, found room and bid from there on the far turn, dueled into the stretch, gained command, shook off CLUBAY and went clear in the late going. CLUBAY bobbed at the break, had early speed to lead into the clubhouse turn then gave it up and tracked the new leader, moved to duel outside of that one on the far turn, bid 3-wide entering the stretch then was outfinished in a long drive. ROYAL DALLIANCE stalked from the outside and was close up into the far turn then failed to match the first two finishers but was clear of the rest at the wire. BALA in touch, saved ground on the far turn then lacked the needed kick. FYNBOS pulled her rider to the lead, was under restraint, dueled into the far turn, was between foes entering the stretch turn then faltered while again under restraint turning for home. CANDY STICK in contact for six, weakened on the far turn.
