WANDO had early speed from off the rail to take a slim lead into the clubhouse turn, shook off rival and went clear down the backstretch, held sway into the stretch then widened as he pleased in the drive. ARCO'S GOLD closed ground from the rail and bid willingly with an inside stretch drive but was no match for the winner and settled for second best. SHOAL WATER pressed the early pace from the outside, kept close and tracked the leader into the far turn, tried to come at the front runner again on the far turn, could not menace but ran on willingly. PEEF came from off the pace to put in a mild 5-path close but was not able to threaten the top three. SOLIHULL trailed then passed tired ones. SONOFAWAC was off a step slow then moved from the outside to be in striking distance for six furlongs then backed away. GAVRO stalked and was up close from the inside then tired on the far turn and faded from the scene.
