BUCK CASH outside foes and checking out a tight group while trailing on the turn, bid five into the stretch then fired and was up in time. LIGHTNING ROUND had a slim lead then was pressured into the stretch, shook clear only to be outdone late. CATS AT WAR saved ground and was in the hunt from the rail into the stretch, waited for a path, angled out in early stretch and finished willingly. BABY BEAR on the pace, was steadied between foes into the turn, kept in the game and put in a mild stretch try. MANDATUM had an outside run and was four wide turning for home then lacked a final kick. ONE BID BLUE pressed three wide early and was a factor between foes on the turn then lacked a finish. BUBBA LUKE was in the mix into the stretch then had no rally.
