### Footnotes

EXPLOSIVE GREEK tracked the leader then bid outside that one and took command into the final furlong, went clear in an off the rail drive and proved best. CHOREOGRAPHY bothered at the break, was in mid pack, gained inside, angled out and finished well. YEAR AFTER YEAR outside of foes and then in the six path and coming on turning for home, continued to close and finished willingly. BAILEYSINHERITANCE came from mid pack and striking distance to be in the five path for the stretch bid then had a mild kick. FLEET STORM trailed the field then was going well late from outside of foes. GHOSTLY CONCERTO led the way after showing good speed, was on the engine turning for home then weakened inside. TOUGH MANCER in mid field, lacked the needed bid. BURGE HOLIDAY HUNT on the pace and on the outside, gave way after being a factor on the turn. LITTLE RED ZIP was off the pace and had no rally. EXPECTED HOUR in the hunt early, backed off and faded. The rider of CHOREOGRAPHY lodged a claim of foul against the winner for alleged interference at the break. After a review the STEWARDS disallowed the claim of foul.
