By subscription of \$100 each to accompany the nomination by Feb.1/01 [360 nominations]; second subscription of \$500 by Feb.1/02 [182 remained eligible]; third subscription of \$1,000 by June 28/02; with an additional \$5,000 to enter. Horses not originally nominated may be made eligible by payment of a late nomination fee of \$7,500 on or before Feb.1/02 or \$15,000 on or before May 15/02. The added money and all fees to be divided as set forth by the Association. All monies received from the original nominations [Feb.1/01] and the Feb.1/02 payments will be divided equally between the gross purses of the Queen's Plate, Prince of Wales and Breeders' Stakes. Race limited to 12 starters. Preference will be given to highest lifetime earnings. Weight: Colts and geldings 126 lbs.; Fillies 121 lbs.

Footnotes

LE CINQUIEME ESSAI stalked the pace of the three front runners after showing four wide speed into the first turn, stayed close and bid 4-wide on the turn for home, took a short lead into the final furlong then was full out in an off the rail drive. BRAVELY unhurried in the early going, was inside of rivals and making up ground into the far turn, went between foes in early stretch, bid up the inside of the winner and finished willingly. ANGLIAN PRINCE never far back in the early going, was between foes on the turn while beginning a bid, came after the front runner from the outside, but could not reach in a good stretch effort. QUESTING KNIGHT well back at the start, closed ground throughout and finished with good energy in the 5-path but failed to threaten the top three. FOREVER GRAND had speed between foes to vie for the lead, dueled into the far turn, was still a factor entering the stretch then weakened on the rail. MISTER COOP bothered at the break, closed ground outside of foes and kept coming through the stretch. SHAWS CREEK never far out of it, kept in touch into the stretch turn then lacked a rally. PHANTOM LIGHT close up early and inside of foes, backed away and had no second effort. FUZZY STAR pressed the early pace from the inside then faded. T J'S LUCKY MOON had early speed, dueled for the lead from the inside, was prominent into the stretch turn then faded. FORD EVERY STREAM had outside speed to press five wide for the lead, gained it briefly, backed off to stalk the leaders, stayed close into the far turn then faltered. CLASSIC MIKE in mid field and between rivals, was in good position to strike but had no bid and gave way.
