HENNESY MOON in mid field, closed fast while inside, bid 3-wide on the far turn, took command in the drive and proved best. DISBELIEF well back, gained off the rail, was in the five path for the stretch try and finished well. INTERTWINED dueled with inside rival for six, took on new foes in the drive and could not match while tiring late. ROAD NOT TRAVELED trailed the field then came home widest and put in a late run. ARCHIEMAN in mid pack and off the rail was inside for the stretch effort but failed to bid. SMART PROSPECT stalked the pace battle while off the rail then lacked a bid. HEDGE ON GOLD dueled inside then tired on the far turn. FAST APPROACHING tracked the leaders then faded.
