Footnotes

HE'S ETAIN showed speed from the outside, dueled on the turn and with a slim lead from the four path at the top of the stretch drew clear. TRUE DESTINY was in touch and a factor from the inside on the turn but from the five path through the stretch was no match for the winner. OUTOFTHEDEPTHS was unhurried early, roused on the turn and raced from the seven path at the top of the stretch but angled inside while all out. CAT N SASSY had no speed, was hustled along from the three path on the turn and from the eight path through the stretch was up for a share. LOVE DESIGN was in range and raced evenly on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch was no real threat. HARDROAD TO HEAVEN was well back and showed little while never dangerous. LET'S GO BEAR was hustled early and had a slim lead on the turn but had nothing left.
