Footnotes

TITANIUM JANE was up close, forced the pace on the far turn and widened under light handling through the stretch. JOKING FEMME was in range, a factor from the three path on the far turn and vied at the top of the stretch but was clearly second best. GENNY'S BEST was unhurried early and trailed the field on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was up for show. WITH ALL DILIGENCE was in touch and saved ground on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch had no impact. SKATING HOME set a reserved pace and dueled from the inside on the far turn but had nothing left. DREAM CRUSADER stalked the leader from the outside and raced evenly on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch lacked a rally.
