Footnotes

MOUNTAIN ECHO was away alertly, dueled from the inside on the turn and widened under light handling through the stretch. TOTAL BLISS was up close and had a bid from between foes on the turn but from the three path through the stretch was no match for the winner. SWEEPING FRONT was in range and a factor from the four path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch leveled off. MAGIC MOONDUST was in touch and had a good position on the turn but finished evenly through the lane. CALL TO SERVE was off the pace and hustled along from the inside on the turn but lacked a serious bid. FLASHY ZEE showed speed and was roused from between foes on the turn but from the four path through the stretch was empty. ZEE'S CURE was hustled early but chased on the turn and had nothing left.
