Plus up to \$8,970 Ontario Bred/Ontario Sired Breeder Awards for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers. Closed Thursday, July 7th, 2005 with 10 nominations.

DEPUTY CURES BLUES tracked the speed battle into the stretch then came on to spit the leaders in the late going and got the nose in front at the wire. CRICKET WICKET dueled outside of rival and pressed through the turn, gave up the lead to inside foe in early stretch, then came again but was outdone by the winner's move. ON SILENT WINGS had inside speed to duel for the lead into and through the turn, led at the furlong pole but was caught by the top two in the final strides. WISDOMISGOLD in touch on the turn and chasing the speed duel, lacked a finishing kick. DECADENT DASH inside and off the pace on the turn, failed to threaten. TETHERETTE trailed in the early going, got by a tired one then lacked a rally. BELIEVE IN MISSY trailed into the stretch and faded.
