Mi PLAYA was away alertly, set the pace, had a clear lead at the top of the stretch and prevailed. CANADIANNE WHISKEY tracked the leader and was a factor on the turn but from the four path through the stretch just missed. HIGHS AND LOWS was in mid pack, roused from between foes on the turn and from the six path through the stretch finished well. JAZZUNTA was off slow, hustled along from the four path on the turn and from the seven path through the stretch was up for a share. INSTANT APPEAL stalked the early leaders and had a good position on the turn but from the six path through the stretch weakened. TELL HER had no speed and raced evenly on the turn but from the six path through the stretch failed to fire. CROWN LAND was in touch but chased from the inside on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch had nothing left. LITTLE MISS TOMMI was well back and showed nothing while not a factor.
