DRUNKEN LOVE stalked the leaders from the outside, was a factor from the three path on the turn and was much the best. LEGAL MOVE was up close, roused on the turn and had a bid from the four path at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner. SHOTEKA pressed the leader early, vied from the inside on the turn and leveled off in deep stretch. FLASHY YANKEE was unhurried early, saved ground on the turn, four path at the top of the stretch and needed more. STUCK IN TRAFFIC set a pressured pace, vied between foes on the turn and tired in mid stretch.
