MARY THOMAS had inside speed to duel then shake clear of the other speed, then kept it going from the rail to prove best. VIRGINIA FORUM never far back, put in a 4-wide bid in the stretch run and finished well. TOWER POWER dueled for the lead, kept battling on the turn, could not go with the winner but finished willingly in a good try. WINGS OF POWER bid 3-wide on the turn for home then evened out in the late going. MAW IRISH HOPE put in a mild bid after coming from off the pace and finished inside. DEMONOUSLY DANCED bumped at the break and steadied on the turn, failed to menace. DR. NATALIE failed to rally while racing off the rail. BUBBLY BROOKE pressed the pace from between foes then tired. SILKS N ROSES was pulled up in the stretch.
