### Footnotes

TROPICAL SOLDIER showed speed, was clear on the turn, had mild pressure through the stretch and drew off. FOURTH TOP stalked the leader, chased on the turn, had a bid at the top of the stretch but was second best. PURE REY (ARG) was in touch, gained ground on the turn, four path at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. EL GRAN MARCO was unhurried early, moved up on the turn, five path at the top of the stretch and finished well. VERY CLEVER BEAU was in mid pack, roused from the inside on the turn and finished evenly. WISE KNIGHT was unhurried early, had a mild gain from the three path on the turn, was a factor at the top of the stretch but faded. WONDEROUS GLORY was in range early, in tight into the turn and no factor from there. BIRDIE BOBBY B trailed the field early, five path at the top of the stretch but failed to fire. INDY JOE was back early, had a mild gain between foes on the turn and gave way in the lane. MELODY OF GOLD was in mid field, showed little and was never a threat.
