Footnotes

PARABOLA settled off the early pace, circled foes on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch drew off. BEAR ALWAYS was rank early and took command into the far turn but failed to hold. VENABLO was back early and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but needed more through the stretch. MONTROSE AVENUE was in mid pack and gained ground from between foes on the far turn but leveled off. LETAPROHAVEAGO had no speed and trailed the field on the far turn but passed tired foes through the stretch. DEPUTY LOR dueled early and was roused on the far turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was empty. KINSTAR showed speed and was hustled from the inside on the far turn but tired in upper stretch.
