**Footnotes**

SILVER STRIP tracked the leader, closed ground and bid outside on the far turn then was full out to prevail. BALLERINA'S HALO never far back, was inside and in touch on the far turn then bid between in the drive and finished off a solid try. TOUCH OF QUALITY was off slow then showed speed and led the way while opening a gap, kept on the engine on the far turn, was pressured and then finished gamely inside. SMILING JORDAN tracked the leader and was in touch early, then evened out in the stretch. JUDITH'S LAKE closed ground from mid field then needed more in the drive. GREAT TORRINGTON off the pace, was on the rail for the stretch bid and then going well late. JEANNE'S KNIGHT in mid pack, lacked a rally. ONE MORE DAY was off the pace and offered no bid. WINGED OVER backed away after pressing early then trailed the field home.
