MOLINARO RUSH had speed from between foes, dueled on the turn, led from the three path at the top of the stretch and proved best. BAILEY'S RING was off slow, had a mild gain from the three path on the turn and from the five path through the stretch was up for place. DUETTINA was up close and a factor from the three path on the turn but from the four path at the top of the stretch was outfinished while on the rail in deep stretch. TENNIS BRACLET was hustled early and roused from the inside on the turn but had no late kick. TAGS AND TOWEL was off the pace and saved ground on the turn while outrun. BLACK NAPKINS had no speed, showed nothing and from the six path at the top of the stretch was never a threat.
