WOODY G led the way through the clubhouse turn, held sway and then was pressured by rivals on the far turn, had something left and cleared again. DELAFORCE in mid field, came on to bid 3-wide on the far turn, finished well but could not catch the winner. FLIP FOR THE COIN chased the speed and was a factor into the stretch only to be outfinished in the drive. LONESOME CHEROKEE kept in touch while inside, stayed a factor into the stretch then lacked a final kick. SEPTEMBER SQUARE in mid field early, failed to find the needed bid and was not a stretch factor while evening out wide. CAPTAIN CHRIS raced off the pace and lacked a serious bid when the final furlong arrived. SHANGHAI KNIGHT tracked the leader early then failed to stay and had no finish. EL GRAYLING came up empty after trailing from the outset.
