Footnotes

TEXAS BLITZ showed speed and set the pace, drifted out in deep stretch but prevailed. D'ORO DIABLO showed no speed, had a mild gain on the turn and was a factor in deep stretch but just missed. IT'SAPOSSIBILITY forced the pace, was roused from the inside on the turn and from the three path through the stretch finished well. STEADY STUART was in mid pack and had a good inside position on the turn but leveled off late. TUMERIC was unhurried early, trailed the field on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. QUARTERBACK was off the pace and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. MOLINARO WARRIOR was in touch and hustled along on the turn but from the four path through the stretch weakened. SENOR RED was in range and raced evenly from the four path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch faded.
