Footnotes

BLINGWHERE'SMYRING was up close, in hand on the far turn and angled out to the five path at the top of the stretch and was all out in deep stretch. SKIP THE NIGHT was in touch, forced the pace on the far turn, was a factor from the five path at the top of the stretch and held place. DANCINGTHENITEAWAY broke outwardly, move up backstretch, vied from the five path at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. PARIS BREEZE was off the pace, gained ground on the far turn, five path at the top of the stretch but needed more. DOMESTIC DILIGENCE stalked the leader, vied between foes on the far turn but leveled off in the stretch. RICH DESTINY was unhurried early, had a mild gain on the far turn, four path at the top of the stretch and evened out. WITH ALL DILIGENCE set a pressured pace, had a slim lead on the far turn and gave way inside through the stretch. FINE EXAMPLE had no speed, chased from the inside on the far turn and tired in upper stretch. PERFECT SUSPECT was off the pace, roused from the four path on the far turn, five path at the top of the stretch in a dull effort. BRITE ERYN was back early, five path on the far turn and was never in contention. CREEMORE was in mid pack, lost ground on the far turn and was not a factor.
