SHANGHAI KNIGHT was unhurried early, closed the gap on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch fought gamely for the win. EXPECT COLONIAL had no speed, moved up on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch had a good effort. GULCH KNIGHT was in range, raced evenly from the three path on the far turn and from the seven path at the top of the stretch closed. IT'S TIME BEAR was in mid pack, had a mild gain from the four path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch leveled off late. ARMORED was in range and had a slim lead on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch gave way late. WONDEROUS GLORY was back early and had a mild gain on the far turn but needed more in the drive. PHILLY FRENZY stalked the leaders and was a factor from the four path on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch tired. LIVE QUOTE was off the pace, trailed the field on the far turn and passed tired foes. ZENKO dueled from the outside and had a bid from between foes on the far turn but came up empty. VIABLE dueled from the inside but chased on the far turn and was tired in upper stretch.
