Footnotes

GUYSMARLENE stalked the pace from between horses, angled in at the eighth pole, responded to a string hand ride, gained control a sixteenth out and outfinished VIOLET DU LIBAN. VIOLET DU LIBAN forced the pace from the hedge, moved to the lead early turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner in the final stages. MADAM CHAIR raced forwardly from between rivals, yielded at the top of the stretch. COPELAN'S VANITY forced the issue from the outside, came four-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. TSAKPINA dueled three-deep to midturn and gave way. ACHINGLY showed speed four-wide, stayed gamely to the top of the stretch and tired. CHINA NIGHTS, well back early, closed outside rivals on the turn but never reached contention. MISS YOU MICHELLE raced evenly between foes. FLIGHT OF FIRE saved ground, lacked a rally. BRENDA'S BABE squeezed back early, raced wide and never menaced.
