QUESTION THAT vied inside of foe and battled into the stretch then cleared and proved best. GUEULES DE LOUP in mid pack, moved from the five path turning for home and finished off a good rally. READ'S BAY never far back, gained and bid three wide into the stretch the finished off a solid try. ATARAH was off a step slow, gained ground and bid from the 6-path turning for home then finished off a good recovery run. AT TWILIGHT closed ground while inside through the turn but it was not enough. HEART OF A QUEEN made up ground but did not menace the leaders in the run to the wire. MONDAY MORNING pressed the pace while outside then tired. ONE FOXY MAMA up on the pace and pressing early inside, backed off and faded. T. V. GIRL lacked rally from off the pace. SKIP THE NIGHT hit the gate at the break and was never in it. NAUGHTY ANGEL was done early and faded from the scene. SCARLETT LANTERN in touch into the turn, tired and faded outside.
