WHEREINEEDTOBE tracked the leaders, looked for a seam in early stretch, angled out, found it and then split foes and drew off. MANDATUM vied inside and was in the front end tussle to mid stretch then not able to match the winner. ZAUBERWALD chased the leaders then put in a late four path try and finished willingly. BABY BEAR stalked the leaders then bid inside in the drive to look a danger but was outkicked. ONE EYED SAILOR forced the pace outside, was a factor on the far turn then gave way in the drive. CAT N SASSY off the pace, swung out wide on the far turn to make a run but lacked the needed finish. CATS AT WAR bumped at the break, was off the pace, trailed and lacked a rally.
