### Footnotes

HIDDEN PROFIT stalked the leader, was hustled along on the far turn, vied through the stretch and drew clear. HIGH PLATEAU was hustled early, set the pace and had a slim lead from the four path at the top of the stretch in a good effort. CATCH THE POSSE was unhurried early, moved up on the far turn and was a factor from the five path at the top of the stretch but weakened. JOEY'S BEST showed no speed and was roused from the inside on the far turn but lacked a late response. EVANGELOS tracked the leaders from the inside but trailed the field on the far turn and lacked a serious bid.
