WIRY WILLIE had early speed to show the way from off the rail, kept the lead throughout and shook off all challengers to prevail under good 4-path urging. ORIENTALSPRINGHOPE off the pace, made up ground from the 5-path on the turn then finished with good energy on the rail to catch the place. ROMAN ROMANCE never far back, saved ground on the far turn, angled out for the drive then evened out in the late going. LA BALLERINE trailed and then a mild move to be in contention on the far turn then had no stretch rally. PROSPECTIVE GAL had early inside speed to press the pacesetter, stayed close into the far turn then backed out of the chasing group and had no second bid. FLEET DEED pressed the pace before fading on the far turn.
