Footnotes

SILENT HUMOR was off the pace, closed the gap on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch rallied to get up in time. CORBELLI was in range, moved up from the three path on the turn and raced from the five path at the top of the stretch but drifted in through the stretch while all out. MR. DANCIN MAN was in touch, hustled from between foes on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was the best of the rest. TRI FOR MR. L was up close and roused from the inside on the turn but was in tight at the top of the stretch and lacked a bid. SOUTH OF DIXIE was hustled early and had a slim lead on the turn but flattened out through the stretch. THUNDERING BREEZE was off slow and trailed the field on the turn but passed a tired foe. PECK ON THE CHEEK showed speed from the outside and forced the pace on the turn but from the three path through the stretch dropped back.
