DOPPLER RADAR was away alertly, set the pace and widened under light handling through the stretch. EUCLID AVENUE was in touch, hustled along from the four path on the turn and from the six path through the stretch was up for place. BEST OF JOHN stalked the early leader but chased from the inside on the turn and from the four path through the stretch weakened. STORMIN HOT was up close and raced evenly from the three path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch needed more. ANOTHERCHICHYBABY had no speed and raced from the four path on the turn but from the six path through the stretch was not a factor. ANNE'S ALPHA BET was off the pace, trailed the field on the turn and had no impact. FAR CANAL was in mid pack and saved ground on the turn but was never a threat. NO YOUR BOUNDARIES broke awkwardly and had a mild gain into the turn but had nothing left.
