Footnotes

VALLEY BREEZE was off the pace, moved up from the four path on the far turn and from the five path through the stretch was up in time. KIOTARI BAY was in range, a factor on the far turn, raced from the four path at the top of the stretch and had the lead in deep stretch but was outgunned. SABINO set a pressured pace and had the lead on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch gave way. BORN TO BOOGIE showed no speed and had a mild gain on the far turn but from the three path through the stretch needed more. PITBULL was in mid pack and saved ground on the far turn but finished evenly. BURI was in touch but chased on the far turn and from the four path through the stretch leveled off. BOULDER SPRINGS was well back and showed nothing while never in contention. THUNDER DANCING forced the early pace but dropped back on the far turn and had nothing left.
