Footnotes

DISCO FLASH stalked the early speed battle, went up outside of foes to press after going a half, vied on the far turn then was full out in the drive to prevail over inside foe. HI POPPY settled behind the pacesetters, gained and saved ground on the far turn, then bid off the rail in the drive, vied and missed to outside foe. SHAMAN GOLD vied from the inside with rivals, took on new foe and dueled through far turn then gave way grudgingly from the inside. BODEAN pressed from between foes, gave way on the far turn and tired inside. BIG BULL N' BOLD in striking distance near the rear of the field after going four, failed to bid. BLUE RODEO had speed to vie early gave way into the far turn and faded. BEES ON HIGH was hung out wide early while pressing the pace then faded after going five and was all done.
